Materials Required for Activity	 Sticks or branches - the amount depends on the size of the Christmas tree you want to create Twine Nail to hang the tree on the wall Scissors Hammer (if necessary) Baubles and lights to decorate
Step-by-step instructions	If you decide to decorate your house for Christmas, make sure the decorations you choose are eco-friendly! Let's make a sustainable stick Christmas tree! (1) Start by measuring out your twine to suit the size of the tree you want to make. (2) Lay the sticks across the twine and make sure you like the position (3) Starting at the top, wrap the twine around the stick twice and then tie in a knot. (4) Repeat for the other side (5) Moving down repeat for each of the branches (Don't forget to make sure your branches are straight!) (6) Once you reach the bottom, tie two knots tight to ensure the





bottom branch doesn't come undone.

- (7) Find a place in your house where you want to hang the tree.
- (8) Hang the tree on the wall.
- (9) Decorate!
