

Etsy  Etsy is an online shopping platform that allows customers to purchase handmade products from small businesses or sole traders. Customers can connect with small business owners across the globe to buy unique, individual crafted products that make perfect gifts. This is a more sustainable form of online shopping as it provides an opportunity for customers to purchase products that are made small-scale and has considerably lessened environmental costs. Below you can find the steps on how you can use Etsy to browse and purchase products from small businesses, and how you can filter your searches to shop locally in Ireland too!		







- Step 1: Download the Etsy app on your phone
- Step 2: Open the app and search for an item you would like to gift
- **Step 3:** Click on the 'Filters' button
- Step 4: Set your 'Shop Location' to Ireland and click 'Show Results'
- **Step 5:** Now you are shopping local! This helps to cut down on delivery costs on both the pocket and the environment, and also helps reduce the harmful production costs of buying from main retail brands.

## **Thriftify**

Thriftify is an online platform that connects customers to a wide variety of secondhand goods available across several charity shop chains across the country. It





allows customers to browse and purchase second-hand goods while supporting charity, and offers fair and competitive prices for a wide variety of products.
