What is the Story?	Fir Transport For Ireland (TFI) is a public transport network in Ireland that includes buses, railways, and trams. TFI's goal is to provide people with the best transport for travelling to work, school, or social outings while reducing congestion, time efficiency, and saving money (National Transport Authority, 2021).
	TFI allows you to plan your commute with the <u>TFI Journey</u> <u>Planner</u> , which gives users straightforward schedules of transport and combines them into easy-to-read journey plans (National Transport Authority, 2021).
	The TFI Go app lets users purchase tickets for public transport services in Ireland on their smart devices. The ticket is then downloaded to your device and there is no need to print it out (reducing paper waste).

Why is this a Good Example to Follow?	TFI (Transport for Ireland) is a great service for students to use as it is very easy to use, cost effective, and is a more sustainable way to travel. TFI provides countless routes, frequent modes of transport at reasonable prices and have many apps that students can download for an even cheaper commute!
	TFI is a great example of how a company can be sustainable. Think about it. It is a lot more sustainable to travel with as many people as safely possible in one vehicle than lots of vehicles who are going to the same place separately adding gas emissions to our environment. Smarter travel equates to an eco-friendly environment!
What Impact has this case study example achieved?	The National Transport Authority (2021) reports that the TFI Smarter Travel is a "national voluntary behaviour change programme, helping employers and third-level institutions to employ voluntary Travel Plans". These plans concentrate on fostering and motivating workers and students to be more sustainable, actively commute, and for organisations to think about incorporating flexible working understandings.
	Colleges are likewise urged to prompt Smarter Travel as a segment of their curriculum and via student projects. Behaviour changes interventions like the annual Step Challenges and Cycle Challenge encourage active travel and help organisations in rousing their workers and students to be more active on their commute and for leisure pursuits National Transport Authority, 2021).
	As mentioned previously, TFI aims to provide people with public transport. This means there is less motorists on the road, which results in lower gas emissions being released into the atmosphere
