You can either start with the SBB website, which gives you an overview of potential railway company relationships (to the SBB website: https://www.sbb.ch/fr/aide-et-contact/produits-services/billets/europe/billets.html). Step 3: Once you are sure of your train itinerary and travel details, buy your ticket from the agency you visited or the Thetrainline website linked to <https://www.thetrainline.com/fr-ch>. It also exists in the form of an app.
